The Events of Christ's Crucifixion In Probable Chronological Order

- 1. Prior to the actual crucifixion, Christ refused the sour wine mixed with gall. *Matthew 27:34; Mark 15:23*.
- 2. Christ was crucified between two thieves. Matthew 27:35-38; Mark 15:24-28; Luke 23:33-38; John 19:18.
- 3. Christ's first statement while on the cross was an appeal to the Father, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." *Luke 23:34*.
- 4. The soldiers stripped Jesus, leaving Him naked on the cross. *Matthew 27:35; Mark 15:24; Luke 23:34; John 19:23*.
- 5. The Jewish leaders mocked Jesus. Matthew 27:39-43; Mark 15:29-32; Luke 23:35-37.
- 6. Jesus communicated with the two thieves, and to the one thief He made His second statement on the cross, "Truly I tell you, today you shall be with Me in paradise." *Luke 23:39-43*.
- 7. Christ made His third statement from the cross to Mary, "Woman, behold your Son," and to His disciples, "Behold your mother." *John 19:26-27.*
- 8. It was dark from 12:00 pm. until 3:00 pm. *Matthew 27:45; Mark 15:33; Luke 23:44.*
- 9. The Lord made His fourth statement to the Father, "My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me?" *Matthew 27:46-47; Mark 15:34-36.*
- 10. Again the Lord is mocked by some, thinking He is calling for Elijah. *Matthew 27:49; Mark 15:36.*
- 11. The Lord made His fifth statement to the Roman soldiers, "I am thirsty." *John 19:28.*
- 12. The Lord drank the sour wine. *John 19:29.*
- 13. The Lord makes His sixth statement from the cross, "It is finished." *John 19:30.*
- 14. The Lord takes sour wine from a sponge. *Matthew 27:48; Mark 15:36*).
- 15. The Lord makes His seventh statement from the cross to the Father, "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit." *Luke 23:46.*
- 16. The Lord dismissed His human spirit by an act of His own desirous will. *Matthew 27:50; Mark 15:37; Luke 23:46; John 19:30.*
- 17. The veil in the temple was torn from top to bottom. *Matthew 27:51; Mark 15:38; Luke 23:45.*
- 18. The Roman centurion cries out, "Truly this One was *the* Son of God." *Matthew 27:54; Mark 15:39.*
